With the completion of a \$10 million restoration in 2006, the Mills House, now more than ever, is your first choice to give your next meeting historic significance.

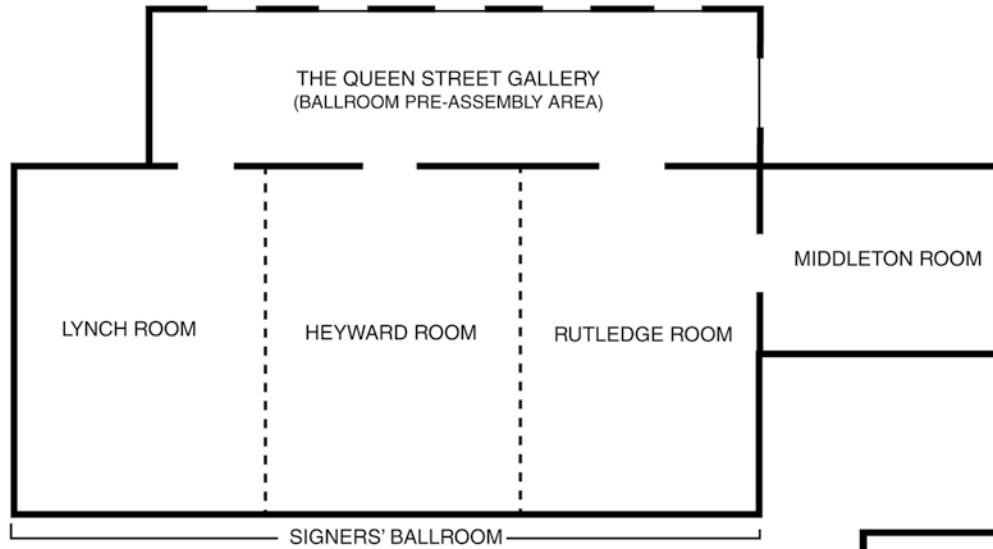

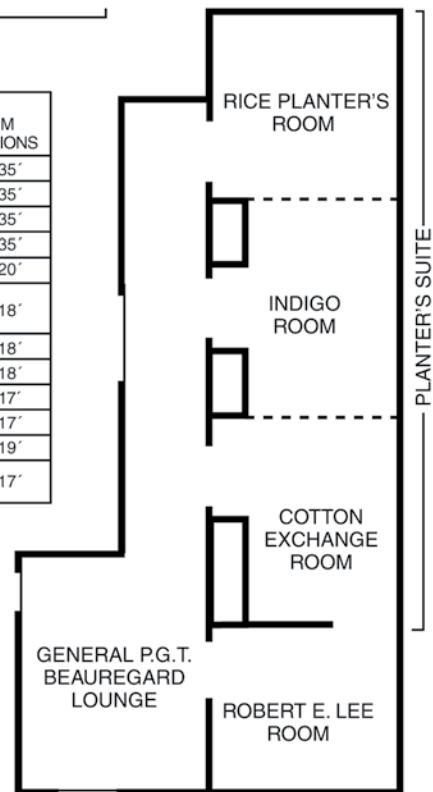
